### **POLICY FOR REPRODUCING COPYRIGHTED MATERIAL**

The University of Louisiana at Lafayette recognizes the fluidity existing between the tenets of copyright and its academic mission. The introduction of the Fair Use Guidelines for Educational Multimedia further defines that relationship in specific instructional circumstances. The Copyright Handbook attempts to do two things: articulate the University's continuing copyright policy, amplify fair use in an educational setting, as well as the Fair Use Guidelines for Educational Multimedia. It incorporates information concerning the Digital Millennium Copyright Act and includes current duration of term dates.
