COURSES FULFILLING CORE REQUIREMENTS OF BOARD OF REGENTS AND UL LAFAYETTE

The following table is meant to give guidance to faculty and students regarding the UL Lafayette courses that satisfy the core education requirements of both the Board of Regents and the University. Please note that a given curriculum may and often does specify a particular course to fulfill a core requirement, so where this table indicates that "any course" may satisfy a given requirement, that is only true in the broadest sense and does not dictate policy or practice at the college or department level.

Natural Sciences–Biological and Physical (9 hrs)	X	X	BIOL (any course, though BIOL 121, 122 recommended for non-majors) RRES 150 PHYS (any course, though PHYS 160, 170 recommended for non-majors) CHEM (any course, though CHEM 101, 102 recommended for non-majors) GEOL (any course, though GEOL 101, 105, 106 recommended for non-majors)	6 hrs must be in a single biological (BIOL) or physical (CHEM, PHYS, GEOL) science, and 3 hrs in the other natural science area not chosen.
Social/Behavioral Sciences (6 hrs)	X	X	ANTH (any course) ECON (any course, though ECON 201 or 300 and ECON 202 are recommended for non-majors) GEOG (any course) POLS (any course) PSYC (any course) SOCI (any course) CJUS (any course)	3 hrs must be at the 200+ level

Humanities (9 hrs)	X	X	Literature (any course in ENGL or MODL that focuses on literary texts, i.e., poetry, fiction, drama, or the essay; does not include linguistics or language courses) History (any course in HIST except 490) Communication (CMCN 101, 200, 212, 202, 203, 310, 302; ENGL creative writing courses and 360, 365; THEA 261)	UL Lafayette core specifically requires 3 hrs each of courses in literature, history, and communication. Any PHIL or HUMN course will fulfill the BOR requirement but not necessarily the UL Lafayette requirements in this area.
Fine Arts (3 cr)	X	X	DANC (any course) MUS (any course, though MUS 300, 301, 302, 303, 304, 308, 360, and 362 recommended for non-majors; voice or instrument lessons may be allowed at the discretion of the student's Dean) THEA (any course) VIAR (any course) ARCH 221 DSGN 121	
Other Arts, Humanities, or Behavioral Sciences (3 cr)		X	Any course in these areas outside the student's major	
Computer Literacy	X	X	The BOR lists no specific hour requirements for this core element. Fulfillment of this requirement is determined by each College.
